

Dr Peter Whelan, Associate Professor in Law, School of Law, University of Leeds



Dr Peter Whelan is an Associate Professor in Law at the School of Law, University of Leeds, where he is the Deputy Director of the Centre for Criminal Justice Studies. He has degrees in law from Trinity College Dublin and a PhD in Law from St John's College, University of Cambridge. A qualified US Attorney-at-Law, Peter is an expert in competition law and criminal law. He sits on the Editorial Boards of five journals (including *World Competition* and *Journal of Antitrust Enforcement*) and has published widely in specialist competition law journals, as well as in generalist law journals (including *Oxford Journal of Legal Studies*, *Cambridge Law Journal* and *Modern Law Review*). He has provided oral evidence on cartel criminalization to the New Zealand Parliament and recently delivered a commissioned report to the Finnish Ministry of Justice advising it on the desirability of introducing criminal cartel sanctions in Finland. Peter recently published a monograph with Oxford University Press on the criminalization of European cartel enforcement. Peter is currently the Managing Editor of *Oxford Competition Law*.
